Uniform Update

Following feedback from many parents and children, we have decided to make a few changes to our uniform to ensure better value for money for our families. The changes also support the fact that the government have asked schools to have less branded uniform items so that families can purchase clothing from different outlets that are more competitively priced due to the ever increasing costs of school uniform.

From September, or as and when you need to replace items this term, school uniform will be as follows:
